

SELF-DECLARATION FORM FOR 8 % REBATE ON ELECTRICITY BILL

As per the eligibility criteria under the 2016 Ontario Rebate for Electricity Consumers Act, you may be eligible to receive an 8% rebate on your electricity bill for electricity consumption starting January 1, 2017. Please complete the following form if you meet one of the following eligibility criteria and return to Niagara Peninsula Energy Inc. at your earliest convenience.

If you qualify for the rebate, we will retroactively credit your account (if needed) to consumption starting January 1, 2017 or to a maximum of two years from the date you provided us with the completed eligibility form.

Step One – Does your account qualify?

To be eligible to receive the 8% rebate on your electricity bill, the account must meet one or more of the criteria below.

Please check all that apply to your account.

- The consumer associated with this account carries on a business that is a farming business for the purposes of the Farm Registration and Farm Organizations Funding Act, 1993, and you hold a valid registration number assigned under that Act or the consumer's obligation to file a farming business registration form was waived pursuant to an order made under subsection 22 (6) of that Act;
- Your account relates to one of the following:
 - A dwelling;
 - A property, within the meaning of the Condominium Act, 1998;
 - A residential complex, within the meaning of subsection 2 (1) of the Residential Tenancies Act, 2006, without regard to section 5 of that Act.
 - A property that includes one or more housing units and that is owned or leased by a co-operative within the meaning of the Co-operative Corporations Act.
- The consumer or the account satisfies such conditions as may be prescribed by regulations under the Ontario Rebate for Electricity Consumers Act, 2016.

Niagara Peninsula Energy Inc. will use the information collected on this form for the purposes of confirming your eligibility as an eligible account for purposes of 8% provincial rebate calculation in support of its obligations under the Electricity Act, 1998, the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998, the Ontario Rebate for Electricity Consumers Act, 2016, applicable Ontario Energy Board Codes and Rules, associated policies, standards and procedures, and Niagara Peninsula Energy Inc.'s license. This information is being collected and used for billing and auditing purposes and will remain confidential in accordance with Niagara Peninsula Energy Inc. privacy policy.



To qualify for the exemption, this self-declaration form must be completed and returned to Niagara Peninsula Energy Inc.

Please note that a declaration form submitted for the Regulated Price Plan and /or the Ontario Clean Energy Benefit, or DRC Exemption does not meet the notice requirements of the 8% Provincial Rebate. An 8% Provincial Rebate Self Declaration form must be received.

You must advise us in writing if your account ceases to qualify for the 8% Provincial Rebate. Failure to do so will lead to the requirement to reimburse Niagara Peninsula Energy Inc. for any credit outside of the eligible time frame.
