# Safety Tips

Avoid using electrical devices with wet hands or near water sources like pools, sprinklers, or puddles.

Only use outdoor-rated extension cords and avoid plugging multiple extension cords together or overloading outlets.

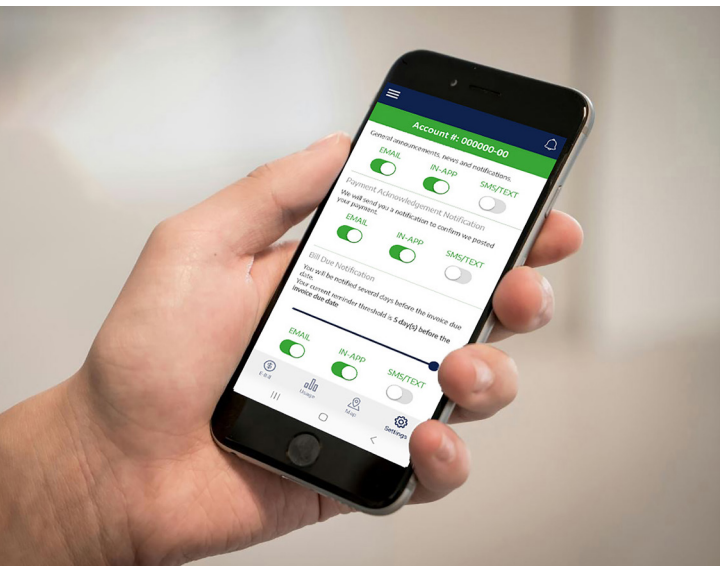
Use GFCIs (Ground Fault Circuit Interrupters) for all outdoor outlets to protect against electric shock.

Look for overhead powerlines when using ladders or trimming trees. Always stay **3 metres** away from overhead powerlines.

You must always **Click Before You Dig** by using the Ontario One Call website. Any time you dig on or near your property, you must submit an online request. Simply provide the details of your project and Ontario One Call will notify the utilities with underground facilities in your area. Contact Ontario One Call at least five business days prior to digging.
