To report a power outage or a downed powerline, please contact our 24-hour emergency line at 1-877-270-3938. To ensure you receive communications about outages, please make sure your contact information is up to date by logging into the MyAccount Customer Portal or by contacting our office.

If your power goes out unexpectedly, check your circuit breakers or fuses. If a circuit has been tripped or a fuse blown, reset the breaker or replace the fuse to restore your power. If you still have no power, contact NPEI.



## **TURN OFF**

the main electrical



### ENSURE ALL

stovetop elements are in the off position.



### TURN OFF

switch.

or unplug equipment to prevent damage should there be a surge when power is restored.

### **KEEP AWAY**

from downed powerlines. If you see a downed powerline, contact NPEI immediately.

AFTER AN OUTAGE plug in only the most essential appliances. Waiting 10-15 minutes before plugging in appliances like refrigerators gives the system time to stabilize.
